

## Leggett-Allen III, Mar-Gregory, and Pope-Bruketta win Adult/Youth Classic

We had a great Adult/Youth classic at Allen's Crosley Lanes in Vancouver on August 7, 2016. Unlike last season when we only had 11 teams that either prepaid or preregistered, this year we had 24 teams. Much better. We ended up with 58 teams and 116 bowlers. Although we had several breakdowns and a couple of equipment delays, it was still a great day. Our fundraiser did a super face plant. Those few tickets have been moved to the September ball raffle.

Shown is the hometown of the juniors, and if they bowled with a former OJC member that we recognize, that adult former member will be in italics. Teams are listed with the junior first and the hometown of the junior. All award dollars are scholarships and are sent to USBC SMART.

In our unlimited "AA" division (390 & up): Michelle & *Eryk Jensen of Gresham* led the way into match play with 2150 with a tight field joining them. From clear down in 6<sup>th</sup> place, Johnny Leggett of Portland & Donnie Allen III rolled through the finals averaging 426 per match and won all 6 matches to climb to the top and win the title with a 4785 total. Michelle and Eryk finished 2<sup>nd</sup> with 4645, Tyler Hogstrom of Burien & Matt Surina finished 3<sup>rd</sup> with 4574, Brian DeLuisa-Anderson of Gladstone & *Nathan Davis* 4<sup>th</sup> with 4482, Bailey Peters of Vancouver & *Ryan Sparano* 5<sup>th</sup> with 4382, and Andrew Sherwood of Mulino & Len Walker 6<sup>th</sup> with 4261. The cut was 2044. Payout was Leggett \$125, Jensen \$100, Hogstrom \$75, and DeLuisa-Anderson \$50. Pictures for the "AA" division were taken with a personal cell and were never sent to us.

In the "A" Division (341-389): Elizabeth & Craig Tuholski of Troutdale qualified first riding the perfect 300 and 822 series by Craig into the finals with 2092. Michael Mar of Junction City & Jeff Gregory stepped it up to win 4 of their 6 matches and move up to capture the title with 4436, Mikayla Hahn of Vancouver & Mark Smudde won 4 of their 6 matches to finish 2<sup>nd</sup> with 4376, The Tuholski's finished 3<sup>rd</sup> with 4305, Stephen Atkins of Damascus & *Dayton Wickham* 4<sup>th</sup> with 4282, Nickolas & Lorie Perini of Hillsboro 5<sup>th</sup> with 4196, and Hannah & Toby Cundell of Bend 6<sup>th</sup> with 4148. The cut was 1928. Payout was Mar \$125, Hahn \$100, Tuholski \$75, and Atkins \$50.
