Grubaugh, Acosta, Brooks, McLean win Husted's Hazel Dell Classic

Donovan Grubaugh of Salem and Tanner Acosta of Lebanon both rolled to two titles in a row. It was Grubaugh's 5th title. Acosta earned his first title last month in the "A" Division, stepped up into the "AA" Division this month and won that title in his first attempt. Joseph Brooks of Portland lost his center (Interstate Lanes) last season and has now found new energy. He was able to squeeze out a 6 pin victory to win his first title and earn his banner in the "A" Division. Emma McLean of Vancouver joined the Classics this month and in her very first try won the "B" Division and earned her banner. We had an exciting tournament and thanks to Storm Bowling and our OJC Leadership Team, the Storm Ball fundraising raffle raised \$832 and increased our scholarship awards at this event by 265%! All dollar awards posted are issued as scholarships and deposited in the USBC SMART Program.

In our unlimited "Classic" division (200 & up):
Donovan Grubaugh-Salem qualified 1st, then won 5 of his 6 matches, keeping everyone at bay to claim his 5th title with a total of 2703. The cut was 950.
