We had a great turnout for the Adult/Youth classic at Allen's Crosley Lanes in Vancouver on August 6, 2017. We had 58 teams with 116 bowlers. Although we had a 1 hour delayed start and several machine breakdowns and equipment delays, it was still a good tournament, even with a 2 hour late finish.
